EXPERTISE AND CLINICAL INTERESTS

Dr Darren Chan is an experienced Family Physician with a foundation in diagnostic radiology and musculoskeletal care. His multidisciplinary background spans primary care, orthopaedics, radiology, urology, and general surgery.



EDUCATION AND TRAINING

Dr Chan obtained his Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery with Honours from Monash University in Melbourne, Australia, in 2012. He went on to complete his Membership with the Royal College of Surgeons (Edinburgh) in 2015, followed by a Graduate Diploma in Family Medicine from the National University of Singapore in 2021. In 2023, he was formally accredited as a Family Physician in Singapore.

CLINICAL EXPERIENCE AND CONTINUOUS EDUCATION

Dr Chan is currently the Medical Director and Family Physician at Atlas Associates Clinic. Prior to this, he served as a Family Physician in several established clinics, taking on key clinical roles across the primary care sector. He did his training in Diagnostic Radiology at Tan Tock Seng Hospital and previously worked as a Medical Officer in Orthopaedic Surgery at the National University Hospital. His early medical training also included rotations in urology, family medicine, and paediatric cardiothoracic surgery. Committed to continuous learning, Dr Chan has obtained a range of clinical certifications to expand his expertise. These include the MOH Telemedicine Course (2022), National X-ray Competency Assessment (2019), and certification as an Advanced Care Planning Facilitator (2016). He has also completed numerous hands-on workshops in surgery, dermatology, and urology, both in Singapore and abroad.

TEACHING AND MENTORSHIP

An advocate for medical education, Dr Chan has taught clinical skills and anatomy at various institutions, including the National University of Singapore, Lee Kong Chian School of Medicine, and Monash University. He has served as a student mentor and facilitator for surgical workshops and continues to support the development of junior healthcare professionals through bedside teaching and academic guidance.

RESEARCH AND PUBLICATION

Dr Chan is actively involved in clinical research and academic writing. His work have been published in several peer-reviewed journals, including The Journal of Radiology Case Reports and Singapore Medical Journal. Notably, he was a contributing author to a book chapter titled “Coenzyme Q10 and Ubiquinol for Physical Performance” in the book Coenzyme Q10: From Fact to Fiction, published by Nova Science Publishers in 2015. His research interests span radiology, oncology, primary care innovation, and surgical techniques. He has also presented posters and oral abstracts at international medical conferences, such as the Japan Primary Care Association and the SingHealth Surgical Congress.

AWARDS AND RECOGNITION

Dr Chan’s academic and clinical excellence has been recognised with several awards, including the Robert Power Prize in Surgery and a Distinction in Occupational Medicine. In 2017, he received the Best Investigator Award at the Japan Primary Care Association Conference for his work on continuity of care and medical records.
